WHO: YOU!! (And Invite a Friend!)

<u>WHAT</u>: Stations of the cross. Stations of the Cross has a long tradition in the Church where we Christians take time to reflect on Jesus' path to the cross and His death during Holy week.

WHERE: At Exeter CRC Church 332 Huron Street W. Exeter Ontario

<u>WHEN:</u> It will take place on Tuesday April 15 from 12-5 pm, Wednesday April 16 from 5-8 pm and Thursday April 17 from 10 am-5 pm.

<u>WHY:</u> To reflect on Jesus' path to the cross to grow deeper in appreciation of His love and sacrifice for us, and to grow deeper in relationship with him.

HOW: Come whenever you like during the available times to participate in the stations and reflect on Jesus' journey to the cross and death. Allow about 30-60 minutes to complete all stations. As you enter the church there is a pamphlet that guides you through each station, where you will read a verse, reflect, and respond. Each station has a tangible sensory reminder of Jesus' experience on His way to the cross. Children are welcomed and encouraged but must be accompanied by an adult. May God bless you by bringing you closer to Him this Holy Week!
